WHAT: Make the holidays “warm” for someone in need. With your company, school or place of worship, collect new and gently used blankets, winter coats, jackets, gloves, scarves, and hats to be distributed to the homeless on the streets and in area shelters via The Mobile Clothing Bank.

NOTES: The Mobile Clothing Bank distributes clothing, blankets and personal care items to persons who are homeless at various shelters in Baltimore City, Baltimore County and Anne Arundel County. The program also conducts street distributions in Baltimore City.

The Mobile Clothing Bank assists approximately 4,800 persons each year. The program receives new or “gently used” donations from clothing collection bins, parish clothing drives, and businesses.
